### DISCERNMENT APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

#### TO FORMATION IN THE LAY CARMELITE COMMUNITY – Part II

The following questions must be used by the community director and/or formation director during the initial interview with each potential candidate for the phase 1 formation program.

1. Initial formation occurs over a period of at least 6 years with usually 2 required meetings per month during the first 3 years, and usually one monthly meeting after temporary profession.

1-A Considering your age and family circumstances, do you feel able to fulfill this degree of required commitment during the formation program? \_\_\_\_\_

1-B Are you willing to explore authentic Carmelite spirituality as a means of personal growth through the process of the Lay Carmelite formation program? \_\_\_\_\_

1-C Do you feel you are willing and able to contribute to community life in some way in order to help the community remain strong and active? \_\_\_\_\_

3. Do you anticipate family responsibilities such as the care of young children, either your own or grandchildren, to become so time-consuming in your life, that they hinder you from living out your Lay Carmelite commitment? \_\_\_\_\_

5. Is your life structured for extended travel/vacation plans? Would you arrange your travel plans so as not to interfere with Lay Carmelite activities most of the time?
